

FARMINGTON TOWNSHIP

ASSESSMENT CHANGE PERMIT

RESOLUTION 07032007

A resolution to require all Farmington Township property owners and /or residents to obtain an Assessment Change Permit for all construction, re-construction, alteration, relocation, demolition of any building or structure, or change in use of property. This does not apply to ordinary repairs.

An Assessment Change Permit will be required regardless of whether or not a building permit is required. If a building permit is required under the Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code, an Assessment Change Permit must be obtained prior to the building permit being issued.

The Assessment Change Permit will be valid for 1(one) year from the date of issue. If the construction, reconstruction, alteration, relocation, demolition, or change in use of property has not taken place within that year, a new permit will be required.

The Assessment Change Permit can be obtained from the township secretary at the township office during regular business hours as posted at the township building. The fee for this permit is set at \$4.00.

The provisions of this resolution shall become effective August 1, 2007.
