

RESOLUTION IMPOSING
ONE PER CENT REALTY TRANSFER TAX

WHEREAS the Supervisors of Farmington Township, Tioga County, Pennsylvania recognize a need for increased revenue in order to meet the increasing costs of services provided by said township, and

WHEREAS said Township Supervisors recognize that many of the townships in Tioga County, Pennsylvania, already impose a realty transfer tax, and

WHEREAS the said Township Supervisors have duly advertised their intention to enact by Resolution a Realty Transfer Tax as required by the Pennsylvania Local Tax Enabling Act.

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved by the Supervisors of the Township of Farmington, County of Tioga, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, that the said township, by virtue of the authority vested in it by the Pennsylvania Local Tax Enabling Act of December 31, 1965, P. L. 1257, Section 1 et seq., does hereby enact and impose a tax on the transfer of real property located within said township. The rate of said tax shall be one per cent, computed and collected in accordance with the regulations of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania applicable to said tax which regulations are incorporated in the Resolution by reference. This tax is to become effective on the first day of July, 1974.
