

ORDINANCE NO. 12

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Farmington, Tioga County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted Act 68 of 1985 setting forth certain guidelines and limitations for the compensation of supervisors of townships of the second class, and

WHEREAS, said act provides that supervisors of townships having a population of 0 to 4999 shall be compensated in an amount not to exceed \$2,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the population of the Township of Farmington is 822, and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly by said Act 68 authorizes the boards of supervisors of the various townships of the second class to determine the compensation of supervisors subject to the limitations set forth in the act,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED as follows:

1. Each supervisor of the Township of Farmington elected or appointed to office on or after November 5, 1985, shall receive compensation as a supervisor in the annual amount of \$480.00 yearly.

2. Such compensation shall be paid in monthly-quarterly installments.

3. This ordinance shall be effective January 1, 1986.
